### DEADLINES TO APPLY

Fall Semester: February 15  
Spring Semester: September 15

About the host university: The University of Copenhagen is the largest institution of research and education in Denmark, with over 37,000 students and more than 7,000 employees. Approximately one hundred different institutes, departments, laboratories, centers, museums, etc., form the nucleus of the University. These activities take place in various environments ranging from the plant world of the Botanical Gardens, through high-technology laboratories and auditoriums, to the historic buildings and lecture rooms of Frue Plads and other locations. On 1 January 2007, the University of Copenhagen merged with The Royal Veterinary and Agricultural University and The Danish University of Pharmaceutical Sciences.

### How to Apply

All applications must go through the USF Education Abroad Office, not the host school. Exchange programs are competitive, students must submit to the Education Abroad Office:

- \* Application Packet
- \* Personal Statement
- \* A letter of recommendation
- \* Transcript
